It has been estimated that 22 million children and youth, ages 6 to 18, are involved in organized sports outside of school. According to researchers at the Institute for the Study of Youth Sports at Michigan State University, kids who participate in organized sports do better in school, have better interpersonal skills, are more team oriented, and are generally healthier. These players are no exception.

This year's team has accomplished the ranking of AAA and will be competing against some of the strongest teams in North America. They have already played in Simi Valley and Anaheim, California and in October, they will be heading to Denver, Colorado. Then they are off to Los Angeles, California for Thanksgiving and Christmas Tournaments.

The 2009-2010 season is very special because the Jr. Coyotes are one of the select teams that will be playing in the Quebec International Peewee Hockey Tournament in Canada. The event takes place from February 11th through the 21st. Approximately 2,300 young hockey players from 16 countries come to this tournament every year. It takes place during a period of 11 days with crowds totaling around 200,000 fans. This extraordinary event, very popular, was founded in 1960 and has never ceased to grow in importance. Many stars from the National Hockey League have passed through this Tournament such as Brad Park, Guy Lafleur, Marcel Dionne, Gilbert Perrault, Mark Howe, Wayne Gretzky, Mario Lemieux, Sylvain Côté, and Eric Lindros.
